WELCOME ABOARD

There are 5 self-guided tour routes that take you to the flight deck, the bridge and decks below.

1

TOUR 1 Flight Deck

Aircraft, Anti-Aircraft Guns, the Plank and Navigation Bridge.

2

TOUR 2 Foc'sle Tour

Officers and Junior Officers Quarters, Pearl Harbor Exhibit and Anchor Equipment.

3

TOUR 3 Gallery Deck

Combat Information Center, Ready Rooms, Library and Captains Cabin.

4

TOUR 4 Lower Decks

Engine Room, Sick Bay, Dental Clinic, Crew's Galley, Mine Exhibit, POW Exhibit and Chapel.

5

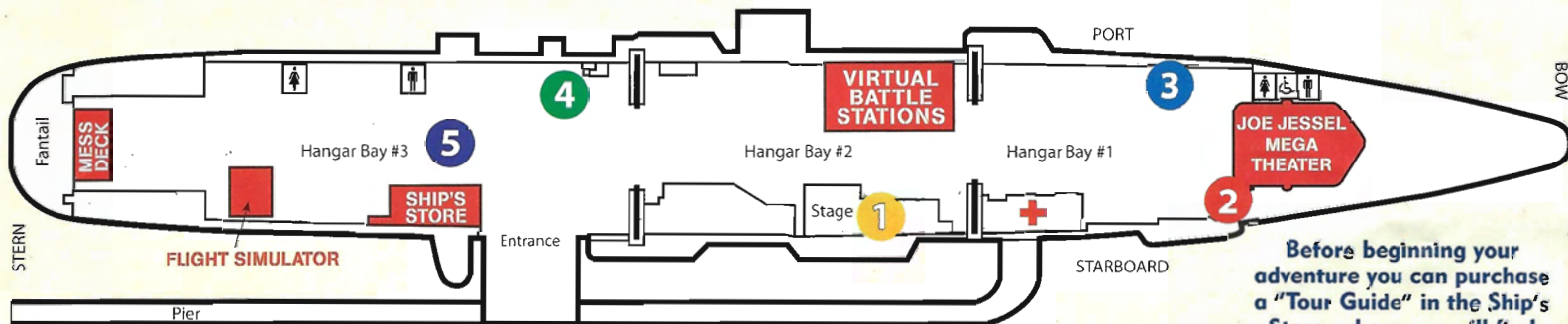
TOUR 5 Hangar Deck

WWII Aircraft, Engines, Mess Deck Cafe, MEGA Theater and Flight Simulator.

All tours begin and end on the hangar deck. Tours 1, 2, 3 and 4 start where indicated on the map. Tour 5 encompasses the hangar deck and has no specific starting point. Take the tours in any order and move along at your own pace to see the exhibits and learn about

USS LEXINGTON'S history. As a former US Navy vessel, the ship has steep ladders, low overhangs and some hazards to look out for. Watch your head and step, keep your children close by and stay on the designated self-guided tour routes.
