



NC-4

The NC-4 Flying Boat is the actual aircraft that completed the first crossing of the Atlantic Ocean by air and is one of the sparks of the aerial revolution.

The World War I exhibit portrays Naval Aviation's role overseas in WWI and includes a Curtiss MF Flying Boat, a Nieuport Fighter, a JN-4 Jenny and a Dodge Ambulance.

never before seen look of a real Vietnam P.O.W. camp. See actual P.O.W. garments, letters written to fathers from their children back home in the United States and much more.


SPACE
