In Case of Emergency ...

Medical Emergency:

Dial 911 and ask for an ambulance and rescue. The fire department rescue unit has an excellent response time. THEN dial the office at 724-962-9800. If after hours emergency, dial 724-988-9444.

Weather Emergency:

We are located in Mercer County. Crawford County is to our North, Lawrence County is South, and Venango County is East of us. Our weather tracks from Ohio in the West, which is Mahoning and Trumbull Counties.

If you feel the need to seek shelter, go to the stone restroom building by the pool. There is emergency lighting there as well.

Pool:

The phone box at the pool is a 911 phone only! In case of a pool emergency, use that phone to call rescue, then immediately have someone with a cell phone call the office.

Hospitals:

The nearest hospital is UPMC Greenville, 7 miles (about 15 minutes) away. Turn right out of our drive and continue through the stop sign to Rt 18; turn right. Go 3 miles and turn right onto Main Street at the light. Go 1 mile and keep left at the fork; the hospital is straight ahead.

The largest hospital is Sharon Regional Health System, 13.5 miles (25 minutes) away. Turn right out of our drive; travel 1 mile and make a sharp left onto Crestview Drive. After 1 mile, turn right on Edgewood Rd., to Rt. 18. Make a left at the light onto Rt 18 South and travel approximately 7 miles to State Street in Hermitage and turn right. Drive approx. 1.5 miles; the hospital will be on your left (740 E State St in Sharon).

For other emergencies, call the park number, or the alternate number if after hours.


