



Discover Mammoths!

Experience an Ice Age museum filled with huge fossils displayed just as they are found!

Time travel to the Ice Age and walk the edges of a sinkhole where Columbian and woolly mammoths, camels, wolves, and giant bears roamed the area and became trapped 26,000 years ago, leaving an ancient treasure of fossil remains. Hear the story of the site; see the animals and the scientific research displayed in a unique setting.

The indoor excavation site features fossils of 59 Columbian and woolly mammoths. The Ice Age exhibit hall displays full-sized mammoth replicas, a walk-in mammoth bone shelter, Giant short-faced bear and new in 2012, Lyuba - a facsimile of the baby mammoth found in Siberia.
