

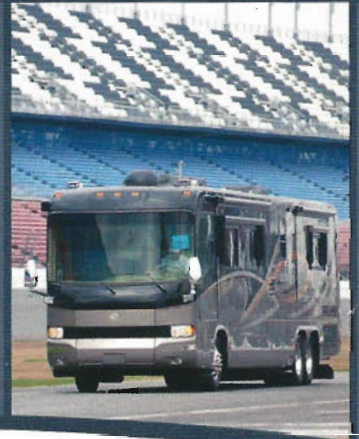

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

RALLY PARKING & REGISTRATION

RALLY RV ENTRANCE PASS

On behalf of the Good Sam Rally team, we welcome you to Daytona Beach and our 15th Good Sam Rally! To facilitate your arrival and that of your fellow Rally guests, we ask that you follow these directions.

Before you arrive...

Please tape both your **Rally RV Entrance Passes** (colored 8½" x 11" cards) in the lower middle section of your windshield. This will allow the Rally volunteer to see it from the ground as you drive through the checkpoint at the entry gate. All cards received should be taped in the lower middle section of the windshield of your vehicle. **Please make sure your RV Entrance Passes are clearly visible so you don't delay our parking process.**

Note: RV Entrance Passes will be identified with either "A.M." or "P.M." If your RV Entrance Pass has an "A.M.," this stands for morning arrival between 8:00 a.m. and noon. If your RV Entrance Pass has a "P.M.," this stands for afternoon arrival between 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. We ask that you please adhere to the specified arrival times noted on your RV Entrance Pass.

The parking staff will look for the RV Entrance Passes on your windshield. These passes will help us direct you to your site as quickly and efficiently as possible.

If you arrive without the RV Entrance Passes on your windshield or arrive on a date other than indicated on the enclosed cards, you will be directed to our Rally Will Call station for registration verification. To ensure everyone's safety, **no vehicle** will be permitted to park without the proper credentials.

Rally participants will enter the grounds using specific assigned entrances, so you should be sure to read the directions in your confirmation packet carefully before driving into Daytona Beach. Routes will be clearly marked where permissible on city streets in the Daytona Beach area.

RV parking is in preassigned lots. If you want to be parked with a friend, you should have registered together, be preassigned to the same parking lot and arrival time, and arrive together. **Likewise, if you're traveling with another guest or a group of guests and wish to park together, you must arrive at the Rally site together and have reservations for the same preassigned parking lot, arrival time and type of campsite (electric or dry). Identify your**

group by placing a piece of white 8½" x 11" paper in the lower-left side of your windshield. Put the name of your group in black marker, followed by the position of each rig relative to the total number in your group (i.e., "Jones, 1 of 6," "Jones, 2 of 6," "Jones, 3 of 6," etc.). Please note: For caravans of five (5) or more, you must have made arrangements to arrive on October 31 to be guaranteed that your group will be parked together.

EARLY ARRIVAL & WILL CALL

If you arrive at the Good Sam Rally before the date shown on your confirmation and wish to purchase early bird registration at the gate, you'll need to report to the Will Call office. Follow the signs to Will Call upon arrival at Daytona International Speedway. We still have a limited amount of space available at this Rally, so if you have friends who would like to join us at the last minute and have not made reservations, they can still register at Will Call.

PARKING DAYS & HOURS

The Good Sam Rally gates will be open for parking from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on all parking days, Wednesday through Friday, October 31 through November 2. Parking gates will close promptly at 5:00 p.m. **There is no overnight holding area. If you arrive after 5:00 p.m., you'll need to return the next morning to be parked.** We suggest that you reserve space at a nearby campground if you plan to arrive in Daytona Beach after 5:00 p.m.

DIRECTIONS

Directions to the Good Sam Rally are included in this packet of information. Please use **only** the directions provided in this packet to guide you to your preassigned parking lot. You could experience unnecessary delays and inconvenience upon entering the Good Sam Rally should you not follow the directions provided.

Please note: The route we've indicated may appear to be out of the way; however, all routes were designated by local police authorities so that you will enter your assigned parking area as quickly and easily as possible. Sometimes, GPS directions don't follow the specific route we're asking you to use. Please follow our directions. We recommend that guests arrive when traffic is the least heavy—after 10:00 a.m. for morning arrivals, and after 2:00 p.m. for afternoon arrivals.

CAMPSITES

When you made your reservation, you were asked whether you wished to be parked in electric or dry (no hookup) campsite areas. Your Rally RV Entrance Pass reflects the type of campsite you chose. If you opted for electricity provided by the Good Sam Rally, it is 30 amps.

Rally campsites may vary in size. Some are 20' x 40', and some are 25' x 40'. Tow vehicles will be parked at your site along with your RV, if space permits. If you have a motorized RV and are towing a trailer, the trailer will be parked separately from your site unless a second site is purchased.

After you are parked...

LOCATOR CARD

You'll receive a Registration/Identification Locator Card after you've been parked that will include the lot name, row and site number where you're parked. Please fill out the locator card completely **before** coming to the Rally Registration and Information Center. This card will provide Rally staff information to help locate you in an emergency.

The Rally Registration and Information Center is located in Yellow Garages 41 through 44 in the infield of Daytona International Speedway. You need to stop by to turn in your locator card and pick up your Good Sam Rally program, foldout map, name badges and goody bag. If you're parked after 5:00 p.m., please plan to register the following morning. Parking is operational from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day, with registration open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday through Friday, October 31 through November 2, and 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 3.

LIABILITY RELEASE

Please sign and bring the enclosed liability release form to the Rally Registration and Information Center.

REGISTRATION

Our registration personnel look forward to welcoming you and providing you with all the information you'll need to make your Good Sam Rally experience enjoyable. At registration, you'll receive a goody bag, name badge(s), lanyards and an official Good Sam Rally program booklet.

SITE ACCESS

If you plan to enter and leave the grounds with your tow vehicle during the Good Sam Rally, please pick up a tow vehicle mirror pass in the Rally Registration and Information Center. This must be displayed on your vehicle at all times and allow our security personnel to identify you as a Good Sam Rally guest who should have access to the grounds.

RALLY PASSPORT PARKING & ENTRANCE

Passport registration holders should follow the directions outlined on the enclosed sheet of directions. Your Rally Passport window card will allow you to park at Daytona International Speedway each day of the Good Sam Rally starting Thursday, November 1, at 9 a.m.

SPECIAL ACCESSIBLE NEEDS

A special information table will be set up in the Rally Registration and Information Center that will provide special accessible needs information.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

Complimentary shuttle service from the parking lots will be available. Your Good Sam Rally program and foldout map will list the hours of operation and shuttle stop locations.

EXTENDED STAY & EARLY DEPARTURE

Please note that extended stays won't be available after the Daytona Good Sam Rally 2012. All Rally guests are asked to vacate the grounds by 11:00 a.m. on Monday, November 5. Guests are welcome to depart on Sunday, November 4, at their leisure. Prorated refunds will not be given for those who choose to depart early.

Please do not leave any garbage bags or trash at your site upon your departure. Post-Rally RV stays are not available.

RALLY INFORMATION

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT DAYTONA BEACH BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME

RV ETIQUETTE

Fresh Water/Holding Tanks—Please come to the Good Sam Rally with a full tank of fresh water. Water delivery will be available onsite for an additional fee. Please arrive with your RV holding tanks empty.

Honey-wagon and water service will be provided by United Site Services. Cost will be \$40.00 per service, cash only. Call (800) 791-8748 to schedule service directly with United Site Services.

Honey-wagon and water service prices are set by the service provider, not the Good Sam Rally.

LP Gas—We ask that you please come to the Good Sam Rally with a full tank of LP gas. Supplies will be available only off the grounds. LP Gas will be available on the grounds by contacting Richard Dittman, from Propane Delivery, at 386-527-8289 to schedule your appointment.

Generators—Please adhere to the generator hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. and be courteous to your neighbors unless you have requested to be parked in the 24-hour generator parking area.

SOUVENIRS

Good Sam Rally souvenirs—caps, jackets, shirts, T-shirts, sweatshirts and lapel pins—featuring the Good Sam Rally logo will be available onsite through Sports Image Apparel of Indiana, the only licensed outlet for Good Sam Rally clothing and souvenirs. FOOD SERVICES

There will be concession stands and food courts on the grounds. Catering onsite for special groups must go through the contracted caterer, AmeriCrown. Please contact Lisa Pinto, senior hospitality/event coordinator, at (386) 681-6499 or lpinto@daytonainternationalspeedway.com.

DAYTONA INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY REGULATIONS

Ground fires are prohibited at Daytona International Speedway. Please remember to use your Good Sam Rally car parking pass at all times for entrance to the Rally. Car passes can be picked up at registration.

TRASH REMOVAL

Trash barrels are conveniently placed throughout the Rally parking areas. Trash will be picked up daily beginning October 30.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms and showers noted in the Good Sam Rally program will be open 24 hours a day beginning October 30.

PETS

Pets are welcome at the Good Sam Rally, but please observe the following restrictions. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Please be kind to your neighbors by cleaning up after pets. If you're planning to be gone all day and are concerned about leaving your pet, please contact a local kennel.

POST OFFICE

Beginning Wednesday, October 31, mail is delivered daily to Daytona International Speedway and is sorted and available for pickup after 10:00 a.m. in the Rally Registration and Information Center. Incoming and outgoing mail may be deposited or retrieved at the Rally Registration and Information Center, October 31 through November 4, 2012. There is no U.S. Postal Service substation on the Rally site due to postal regulations and staffing issues. Sorry, but we aren't authorized to sell stamps or provide Express Mail services. *Mail sent from the Rally after 9:00 a.m. is mailed the following day.*

SERVICE ARRANGEMENTS

RV manufacturers, aftermarket product manufacturers and suppliers exhibiting at the Good Sam Rally have been invited to provide emergency service performed by trained personnel, as a convenience for Rally attendees. Since space is limited, service and installation vehicles will be dispatched to the RV parking areas to perform the work. Good Sam Rally participants needing such emergency service must contact the appropriate company at their exhibit booth or at the servicing company's display area. Service arrangements can be made beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, November 2, when the supplier exhibit areas open. Financial arrangements for the payment of service work are the mutual responsibility of the servicing company and the RV owner and not the responsibility of the Good Sam Rally.

CHURCH SERVICE

A nondenominational church service will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 4, at the Day Stage.

EXHIBITOR MOVE-IN

Exhibitors participating in the RV expo trade show will move in during early bird days. Please don't attempt to visit the exhibit areas during this time. A special RV Preview of motorhomes and travel trailers will be held on Thursday, November 1 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The supplier exhibit areas will open at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, November 2. Hazardous conditions exist in the exhibit areas, and every effort will be made to reduce the risk of injury by not allowing nonexhibitors to enter the supplier exhibit areas before Friday, November 2, at 10:00 a.m.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

The Good Sam Rally emergency number is **(386) 681-5419** and will be located on the back of your name badge. This number will connect you to the Good Sam Rally security office. When calling the Good Sam Rally emergency number from your parking area, give the dispatcher your location exactly as it is listed on the back of your name tag. (You will need to write down your specific locator information on the back of the name badge.) If your emergency occurs after 5:00 p.m., please call 911.

The first aid station is located in the Halifax Medical Center in the infield, next to the big white exhibit tent. To assist emergency personnel in locating a site, guests needing emergency assistance are urged to turn on their headlights and sound their horns.

SECURITY

24-hour security will be provided in all parking lots. You must display your Good Sam Rally tow vehicle mirror pass at all times to enter the lots. Security will be strictly enforced for your safety, so please carry your Good Sam Rally identification—Good Sam Rally tow-vehicle mirror pass and name badge—with you at all times. For the safety of all Good Sam Rally guests, please observe the directions of security personnel at Good Sam Rally checkpoints and on the Good Sam Rally grounds.

RALLY ACTIVITIES

DOG SHOW

The 11th Rally Dog Show, Racing Dogs, will be held on Saturday, November 3 at the Day Stage starting at 10:00 a.m.

ENTERTAINMENT

Our Rally entertainment headliner is none other than the “Queen of Country,” **Reba McEntire**, performing on November 3. **Katharine McPhee** from *American Idol* and the hit TV series *Smash* performs on November 2. Evening entertainment will be in the grandstand located west of Gate 7, and gates will open at 6:00 p.m. Daytime entertainment will be held on the Day Stage at the Bistro Stage area. Check the Rally program and foldout map for the Day Stage entertainment schedule.

GOOD SAM SMILES

When you register, you’ll be given a number of Good Sam Smile tickets, which you can place in the Smiles drawing receptacle at the Rally Registration and Information Center and also in Booth 543. Winning Smile tickets will be drawn daily, and winning numbers will be posted in Booth 543. You can also “earn” more Smiles by participating in Rally activities and visiting participating vendor booths.

PROJECT LINUS—2012 BLANKET DRIVE

The Rally is recruiting “blanketeers” for our 2012 blanket drive to benefit Project Linus. RV SAFE DRIVER TRAINING PROGRAM

A six-hour onsite RV Safe Driver Training program will be offered on the second early bird day, November 1, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. This program is designed to increase driver awareness, identify drivers' abilities, understand and identify drivers' vehicle(s), determine conditions that affect driving and make participants safer drivers. Everyone completing this course will receive a certificate that may entitle them to a discount on their insurance rates. The terms and amount of discounts will vary by state and company, so check with your insurance agent regarding your RV coverage. The cost is \$85.00 per person and includes instruction and a certificate of completion.
