

CLIMATE: The summer climate is ideal. The nights are cool and sometimes frosty. The days are warm and balmy. It seldom rains during the summer months.

FISHING: Diamond Lake is renowned as the best trout lake in Oregon. It is rightly call *The Gem of the Cascades*. Large Rainbow trout are easily taken on bait, troll and fly. Excellent fishing is available at the Rogue and Umpqua Rivers within easy driving distance from the park.

SWIMMING: Sandy beaches are to be found at both ends of the lake and are very popular with the whole family during July and August. Water skiing is not permitted at Diamond Lake.

**BICYCLING:** A paved 11 mile, off road path offers a scenic tour of the Diamond Lake area.

RIDING: Bridle paths surround the lake. Gentle horses will take you over well-marked trails to nearby lakes and scenic attractions.

HIKING: The famous *Pacific Crest Trail* is at you back door and you will find many miles of forest trails in the area. Short excursions of less than one day can be made to many waterfalls and other fishable lakes and reservoirs.

**DINING OUT:** The Lodge Dining Room serves excellent meals and specializes in steaks and chicken. Also, there is the addition of a beautiful upstairs cocktail lounge. There is also a Pizza Parlor across the road from the RV Park which provides a varied menu.

Check-out time is 11:00 am. Sorry, no rent refunds. We cannot control the weather or fishing.

Rates to be determined and **paid in advance**. Rates are for two people, one R.V. and one vehicle.

All guests and visitors **must** register at office. Car passes must be displayed while in the park. Day use fee applies to all non-registered visitors.

All boat trailers, visitors and extra cars must park in the designated area. Each R.V. space has parking for one vehicle only. **No exceptions.** 

Tents are not allowed. Appropriate screened porches are allowed for eating only. No sleeping is allowed in screened canopies. All canopies & screen porches must have prior management approval.

Generators **are not** allowed. All sites are equipped with electrical service.

Pets. Your dog's mess is your mess. All dogs must be on a leash at all times. Never leave your dog unattended. Vicious or barking dogs will not be allowed.

fires are permitted in the existing firepits only. Do not leave your campfire unattended and please extinguish your fire with water before retiring or leaving the park.

Fish cleaning is not allowed in the Park. Fish cleaning stations are provided by the Forest Service and are located near the launching ramps at both the south and north ends of the lake.

No washing of vehicles or rigs permitted in the park.

Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.

Clotheslines and tarps **are not** permitted at R.V. sites. Clotheslines are located near the Laundry Room. Laundry room hours are 8am - 5pm.

Speed limit in the R.V. Park is 5 MPH.
