

- CHECK IN. All vehicles entering the park must register at the office. Please check
 with the office before moving from your assigned site. If you pay in advance for
 six days, we are happy to give you the seventh day free.
- 2. <u>CHECK OUT</u> Check out time is 11:00 a.m. mountain time. Please re-register by then if you wish to stay another day we'll be delighted! If you need to stay only a few hours more, our rate is \$18.00 until 2:00 p.m. and full rates thereafter.
- 3. BEARS. During Spring and Fall we may ask you to place any trash in our recepticals before 7:00 p.m. or not until the next morning. By cleaning out our recepticals around 7:00 p.m., we find bears don't stop by for an evening snack. Of course, all food items and coolers should be scored in your vehicle over night.
- 4. EMERGENCIES. If there is an emergency involving personal injury or destruction of property and our store is closed, first dial 911, then our toll free number (1-888-247-8734) to Inform us of the problem. At any time when the store is closed, please don't hesitate to call us on our toll free number and we will assist you.
- FIRES. You are welcome to have a fire in the ring on your site. Breaking of branches, gathering of burnable materials, or demolishing stumps for firewood is prohibited.
 Wood from our own downed trees (hand split by us) is available for purchase in the store.
- 6. GAME ROOM Open at 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during the summer season. You'll find coin-operated games and a pool table, a large variety of current magazines, a bulletin board with varied information and free travel brochures. Read or play and cool off in air conditioning during a hot summer day. We'd be pleased to have you sign our guest book by the magazine rack.
- 7. <u>LAUNDRY</u> Open 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. during the summer season and air conditioned. You can enter through the marked door at the back of the building or through the game room door at the front of the building. Quarters, soap and fabric softener are available in the store. Please start wash before 7:30 p.m.
- 8. PARKING. Please discuss additional parking needs (your own or a guest's) at the office and refrain from parking vehicles on the grass or on adjacent sites.

- 12. POOL: Our pool is propane heated for your enjoyment. No life guard is on duty; children 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Please leave food and glass containers outside the pool area.
- 13. PROPANE, Ask at the store if you would like to purchase propane.
- 14. QUIET HOURS. Please observe our quiet hours from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. If there are disturbances by other guests that are keeping you awake, call us from the phone booth on our toll free number (1-888-247-8734) so we can restore quiet for everyone.
- 15. <u>RESTROOMS AND SHOWERS.</u> We take pride in providing spotless facilities for you. They will be closed from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for cleaning. Please let us know if anything requires our attention. Children playing in the restrooms will be asked to leave the restrooms.
 (Pets are not allowed in the restrooms)

- RUGS AND MATS. Rugs and mats kill our grass. Please help us by placing them only on the gravel.
- SPEED LIMIT. For safety and in consideration of others, please observe our 10-mile-per-hour speed limit.
- 18. STORE. Our hours vary depending on the season; check the hours posted on the door. Air conditioned for your comfort, the store offers ice cream, limited groceries and RV supplies, and more than 200 rental videos. Come see our unique carvings, and made-in-Montana gift items. We'll get your mail to the post office for you if you'd like to drop it in our mailbox Inside the front door (we have stamps, too). - 19. TRAYEL INFORMATION. Need ideas for things to do? Ask at the registration desk where maps and brochures are also available, or help yourself to information from the brochure racks in the game room.
- TV STATIONS/SATELLITE DISHES. Non-satellite TV reception is usually poor. Repeaters
 are located on a mountain east of the park; you may be able to get Channels 5 (NBC)
 and 10 (ABC). For satellite users, our zip code is 59866.
- 21. VIDEOS. Choose from more than 200 rental videos in our store.
- YISITORS, Visitors of registered guests are welcome to register and use our facilities
 for an extra \$4 (plus tax) per day. Only registered guests are permitted to stay overnight,
 and to use the restrooms and pool.
- 23. WALKING, IOGGING, BICYCLING. For those who like to measure their efforts, the perimeter road in camp is 1/4 mile around; the frontage road from our entrance to the stop sign at Little Joe Road is 1/2 mile. For reasons of safety, please refrain from using bicycles, skateboards or roller blades on the concrete around our building.
- WASHING OF VEHICLES. Full-scale washing of vehicles is prohibited. However, touch up
 with a bucket and squeegee is fine.
- 25. WATER PRESSURE, Our water pressure does not exceed 50 p.s.i.
