PARK GUIDELINES & RULES

This is a license to use the campsite. It is revocable at the discretion of the Board of Directors for any or no reason. Upon revocation you will receive a 10-day notice to quit. If you do not leave the premises, a legal proceeding will be brought against you. In that legal proceeding, you will be charged, and you are hereby responsible for, the costs and expenses of the legal proceeding, including but not limited to attorneys fees.

- All campers must register.
- RESTRICT your speed to 5 MPH while in the park.
- Two vehicles per site. If additional space is needed, please park in the overflow area.
- Children under six must be accompanied by an adult while in the bathrooms.
- After dusk, we ask that no children leave their site without an adult.
 This is for your safety and protection.
- Showers are for camper's use only. Please help us by cleaning up after yourself.
- Please do not pick the flowers or climb, cut or deface any tree or shrub. This work is done by volunteers and should be respected for the work they have done to keep the park looking nice.
- No automobile repair or maintenance is to be done on your site, except in case of an emergency.
- Fires must be kept in the fire rings. Damage resulting from fire is the responsibility of the camper, not the park. If the weather is extremely dry, please check with the office before starting a fire. No 24-7 fires.
- Pets welcome. 2 per campsite (dog or cat). All pets must be kept on a 6-foot leash. It is your responsibility to pick up and dispose of all droppings left by your pet anywhere. Restrain your dog from barking and disturbing others. Pets cannot be left outside unattended or tied to a tree.
- Please do not litter. Put trash in the designated containers. Do not burn trash or garbage.
- Do not drain sewage and gray water onto the site.
- Fireworks and firearms are strictly forbidden.
- There will be an additional charge of \$50 per month for having a freezer or large refrigerator on your lot.
- Do not leave air conditioners running while you are gone from your site.
- If you use any of the park's equipment, such as the shuffleboard or horseshoes, they must be returned to the Rec. Hall where you found them. Please do not abuse this rule or they will be locked up again. Thank you.
- The Country Music Park is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- No additional guests or visitors during any of the outside shows.
- The Honey Wagon will come around on Mondays and Fridays. If you wish to take advantage of this service, please contact Jack at site #36. He will explain how he operates.
- Quiet hours begin at 10:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and midnight Friday and Saturday.
- There shall be no fighting or unruly actions on the part of any campers or you will be asked to leave without any refund! You must also follow the above guidelines. Any questions may be brought up

- to the Managing Director, who will bring your concerns before the board of officers for a decision. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- If you are a seasonal camper, you are responsible for mowing the lawn on your site, as you know where your cords and hoses are, also for keeping your lot looking nice.
- No animals are allowed in any buildings unless it is a seeing eye dog.
- We hope you enjoy your stay and will recommend us to your friends and relatives. We would like to change the image of the "Best kept secret in central New York."
- When driving a motorized vehicle, for example, a scooter, in the park, it must be driven by an adult. If your vehicle requires a license to drive on the highway, it also requires a license to drive in the park.
- When riding a bicycle in the park, all children shall wear helmets. This is a New York State law and shall be enforced.
- There will be <u>absolutely no swimming in the pond</u>. No exceptions.
 No floating devices of any kind on pond.
- If you receive any warning on a park violation, that will be the only
 warning you will receive. The next violation will mean that you will
 be asked to leave the park and there will be <u>NO REFUND</u>.
- It is the park's policy that no refund will be given if you simply do not want to stay at the park. If there is a valid reason for your leaving, such as a death or injury etc., consideration will be given upon board's recommendation.
- There will be no washers or dryers used on the premises.
- No clotheslines can be used for laundry purposes, except for wet towels.
- There will be no renting or subleasing of your camper while on the park property.
- Fishing is catch and release only.
- Any problems on the site, for example with water or electric, lawn mowers etc., please see Mahlon Irish on site #1. If he is not available, please contact the office.
- Any work done on a campsite, other than mowing at this park, must be cleared by the park office before being done. This includes but is not limited to the following: Adding gravel Digging in the ground for any purpose Installing Satellite dishes other than on a tripod or on a camper Moving, changing or defacing any existing Facilities Cutting, defacing or moving any trees or plants Putting up any overhead ropes, lines or wires Building permanent decks. Any changes to the campsite or grounds without the permission of the management shall be construed as a violation of the park rules. Thank you and please enjoy your stay.
