



GUIDELINES FOR COURTEOUS CAMPING

REGISTRATION: Campers and guests must register and pay at the office upon arrival. Passes must be displayed in vehicle window. Day guests must leave the park by 9:00 PM.

PARKING: All vehicles will be escorted to their assigned site. Please respect and respond to the directions given by the escort.

CHECKOUT: Check in and out time is 12:00 Noon. Please re-register by 10:00 AM.

SPEED LIMIT: Please obey the 8 MPH speed limit. There are lots of children.

PETS: Pets are allowed but must be leashed and kept under control. Dogs may not be left unattended while campers are away from the park. Campers must clean up after their pets. Maximum of 2 pets per site.

RESTROOMS: We ask your help in keeping our restrooms clean.

POOL: Open 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM. No glass containers are permitted in the pool area, and no food or drinks inside the pool fence. Children 14 and under MUST be with an adult. No lifeguard on duty. No diving or flips from the pool deck. Posted signs must be obeyed. Swimsuits, only; no cut-offs.

QUIET HOUR: 11 PM until 7 AM. Music and voices should not be heard beyond your campsite.

CHILDREN: Must be in their own campsite by 10:00 PM or dusk. Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Children 6 and under must be supervised at all times.

TABLES: One picnic table is provided for each campaite. Do not take tables from other sites.

CAMPFIRES: Permitted in fire rings only and must be a reasonable size. Do not leave your fire unattended. Do not throw bottles or cans into the fire. Burning garbage in fire pits is against city ordinance. Please extinguish your fire by 11:00 pm or when leaving your campsite. Use water to douse out glowing embers completely. Wood may be purchased at the store or you may bring your own, but please do not collect wood from the park or adjacent properties.

FIREWORKS & FIREARMS: Fireworks and firecrackers are prohibited. Firearms and archery equipment may not be used in the park. This includes BB guns, pellet guns, bows, and arrows, slingshots, and any type of firearm or explosives.

LITTER/GARBAGE: Please be responsible for your own litter including cigarettes. Place all garbage in garbage bags and place in the Dumpster provided. Please recycle aluminum cans in bins provided. Please leave your campsite as clean or cleaner than you found it. Thank you.

CLOTHESLINES: Clotheslines, permanent structures, and excessive materials are not allowed at your site unless approved by management.

GENERATORS: Please ask about our policy for generator use.

FISHERMEN: Please clean fish only at fish station at boat launch. We provide free fish freezing for your catch if properly labeled with your name, site #, species of fish. Each fish must be individually wrapped.

SEWAGE: Please refrain from putting diapers, feminine hygiene products or other such items in your holding tanks. (It plugs up our system.) It is against state law to dump gray water on the ground. Donuts or screw-in elbows are required.

NO REFUNDS: Camping is an outdoor experience. Therefore, we do not give refunds due to the discomforts of nature or if you leave early.
