

PARK GUIDELINES

- 5 MPH: For the safety of all our guests.
- ONE WAY ROADS: Please observe for everyone's safety. Stay on roads. DO NOT drive through sites.
- QUIET HOURS: 11PM-8AM
- CHECK IN TIME: 2PM CHECK OUT TIME: 12NOON Check at the office if leaving later as fees apply.
- PET POLICY: Pets must be kept on a VISIBLE 6 foot leash at all times. Do not leave pets unattended on your site or in your RV. No barking dogs. Pets must be walked on the outer perimeters of the campground...droppings must be picked up immediately. Sites are not the dog's potty area. Pets are not allowed in the playground area, restroom building, laundry room, pool area or store except for service dogs. We do not allow Dobermans, Rotwiellers or Pit Bulls or mix of these breeds.
- SEWER: Sewer line MUST be connected with a sewer seal. DO NOT use the water faucet at your site or any other site to rinse your sewer hose nor let the sewer hose water run on the ground for any reason.
- GRAY/WASTE WATER: Please use dump station. Dumping on the ground attracts animals and causes unsanitary conditions. MUST have a long enough sewer hose to properly use the dump station. Instructions are posted.
- PORTABLE TOILETS: Must be emptied at the dump station only.
- VEHICLES: On the pull through sites vehicles are to be parked behind or in front of your RV. Limited to 2 vehicles on your site plus the RV. No parking on the side of your RV. Do not drive through sites (use the roads) Do Not park on an empty site unless you are willing to pay the site fee.
- CAMPSITES: Please respect the rights of other campers by not cutting through campsites. Please keep your site clean and litter free. ONE CAMPING UNIT PER SITE.
- CAMPFIRES: DO NOT move fire rings. Please make sure your fire is completely out before going to bed or leaving your site. No cutting limbs or trees. Wood is available at the store. Do not bring firewood into the campground per DNR recommendations due to the spread of diseases and insects among the trees. Website: mi.gov/dnr if you have questions. DO NOT LEAVE GARBAGE IN FIRE RINGS. (Please put all cigarette butts in the fire rings...thank-you)
- FIREWORKS/FIREARMS: Not permitted for use in the park.
- MOPEDS, MOTORBIKES, MOTORCYCLES, ATVS, ORVS or SIMILAR VEHICLES: You may only ride them to enter and exit...otherwise NO riding in the park. Observe and obey all signs including the speed limit.
- CHILDREN: Must be supervised at all times. Young children should be accompanied at the playground and MUST be accompanied in the restrooms/showers and pool by an adult. 18 and under must be on their sites by 10PM or dusk whichever occurs first.
- RVS/VEHICLES: No washing or rinsing of units. No major repairs...emergency repairs only. Please stop at the office if you have any questions.
- NO SMOKING WITHIN 25 feet of the restrooms/showers, laundry room, pool and play areas as they are all SMOKE FREE AREAS.
- CLOTHESLINES: Permitted if attached to your RV but only on a temporary basis. Please do not attach clotheslines to the trees.
- VISITORS: Please advise your visitors in advance there is a \$3.00 charge per day per person. (Fee does not include pool use.) They MUST stop and register at the office and park in the designated area. All visitors must leave by 10PM. You are responsible for your visitors.
- DAMAGING OR DESTROYING OF PROPERTY: You will be expected to make full restitution. All sites are checked prior to your arrival.
- ALCOHOL: Please use moderately and on your site only. No underage drinking permitted.
- GARBAGE: Place in the dumpster at the Northwest entrance of the campground. All garbage must be in plastic bags. Please break down boxes to help conserve space. NO freshly cleaned fish parts...must be buried. See office.
- BIKES: Must be ridden on the roads. DO NOT ride through the campsites or on the sidewalks.
- POOL: The Michigan Pool Rules are posted on the fence gate & on back of park guidelines.
- **REFUNDS:** No refunds for weather conditions or unused days.
- TERMINATION: Termination of tenancy can result from violations of any park rules or misconduct. No refunds.
- Irons RV Park and Campground LLC is not responsible for any losses or damages due to theft, fire, acts of God or acts of other campers.

POOL RULES

(The pool rules are the ones required by the Michigan Dept of Environmental Quality for the operation of a pool in a campground in order to provide a safe and healthy pool for your enjoyment)

- 1. All bathers shall use the toilet and particularly to urinate before taking a cleansing shower bath before entering the pool.
- 2. All persons using the swimming pool shall take a cleansing shower bath, using warm water and soap, and thoroughly rinsing off the soap suds before entering the swimming pool rooms or enclosure. A bather leaving the pool to use the toilet shall take another cleansing shower bath before returning to the swimming pool room or enclosure.
- 3. Persons having or reasonably suspected to have any considerable area of exposed sub-epidermal tissue, cuts, or known recognizable contagious or communicable diseases, cough, cold, open sore, blisters, bandaged wound, fever, inflammation of the eyes, nasal or ear discharges, shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- 4. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose and other similar behavior in the swimming pool will be strictly prohibited.
- 5. NO RUNNING, JUMPING, DIVING, BOISTEROUS OR ROUGH PLAY shall be permitted in the pool, on the runways, diving boards, floats, platforms, in dressing rooms and showers.
- 6. Bottles, crockery, glassware, or other hazardous objects shall not be permitted within the pool fence area, pool room, bathhouse facilities, or in the swimming pool or on the deck area.
- 7. No children under 18 in the pool or pool area without adult supervision.
- 8. No person shall bring or throw into the pool or its floors, walkways, aisles, or dressing rooms, any object that may in any way carry contamination or endanger the safety of any bather.
- 9. Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be prohibited from entering the pool or pool fenced area.
- 10. Unsupervised solo bathing shall be strictly prohibited.
- 11. All bathers must use the appropriate swimwear i.e. bathing suits/swim trunks only. Street clothes shall not be allowed in the pool...NO shirts of any kind while swimming.
- 12. Consumption of food and or beverages and use of tobacco products shall not be permitted in the swimming pool or on the deck area. (NO SMOKING within 25 feet of the fenced area)
- 13. All animals with exception of guide animals for the handicap shall be prohibited within the pool fence, pool room or bathhouse facilities. (NO animals within 25 feet of the fenced area)
- 14. The pool shall not be operated during severe weather conditions, i.e. electrical storms, tornadoes, etc. (If you hear thunder there is lightning)
- 15. No diving is permitted off the deck into shallow areas of the pool... **Absolutely NO DIVING** permitted.

ALL babies, children not toilet trained, adults with incontinent problems MUST wear swim diapers.

NO swim fins in pool. Goggles must be kept on face when in pool. Only soft pool toys allowed in the pool and pool fenced area.
