**Cabin #4:** Camping cabin with 1/2 bath, cable TV, and refrigerator. \$40.00 + tax.





# Raccoon Mountain RV Park & Campground Rules & Regulations

We all have rules and these have been established for the comfort, convenience, and, most importantly, safety of everyone. Your cooperation is appreciated by your fellow campers as well as by your hosts. Please be considerate and enjoy your stay with us.

- Check out time is at 12:00 noon. Camping fees are payable in advance at the time of check-in. If you would like to extend your stay, or if your departure will be delayed past check-out time, please notify the office. A \$5.00 per hour service charge applies to all checkouts after 12:00 noon.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM. You are encouraged to report violations.
- The cutting of standing timber, trees, or any plant is strictly prohibited.
- The campground, buildings, and amenities are to be used at your own risk. Management cannot be responsible for damage caused by falling tree branches, tree nuts, etc. Firearms of any kind are prohibited.
- Visitors are permitted only from 8AM – 10 PM provided that they are registered in the office.
- The speed limit on all campground roads is 10 MPH – Be careful as children may be around.
- An adult should accompany children at all times – especially inside the bathhouse.
- The swimming pool is for registered guests only. An adult must accompany children under the age of 16. Please observe the posted rules. Registered campers may have up to 2 guests/ visitors at the pool with them but the guest must be registered in the office and be accompanied by the registered camper at all times.
- There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY at the pool so you must SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted only on your site. It is against the law in Tennessee to have any type of alcoholic beverage off of your site or in any building or common area (pool area, playground, etc.). Lack of moderation will result in your being asked to leave (without refund) and / or the county sheriff being called.
- Please keep your site neat and orderly. Do not throw aluminum, glass, or trash into the fire rings. A \$25.00 service fee may be imposed for removal of these items or for excessive trash left on the site.
- There is absolutely NO SMOKING in any building by order of the Fire Marshall. Tennessee state law imposes a \$300 fine for smoking in a public building.
- Only UL approved electrical cords may be plugged into our boxes. The Electrical Inspector requires that all cords be continuous, without splices, from the outside of your RV to the receptacle.
- The Health Department requires that a “donut” be used at all sewer connections.
- State law prohibits the discharge of any fluid onto the ground. This includes both grey and black water.
- Washing cars or vehicles of any kind is not permitted. There is a car wash nearby in Lookout Valley.
- Our sewer lines are designed to dispose of human waste only. Please do not dispose of food, grease, plastics, hand wipes, etc. into our system.
- The use of on-board washers and dryers is prohibited.
- Outdoor appliances are strictly prohibited. The written permission of management must be obtained before placing any item outside your RV other than a BBQ grill, lawn chairs, or a cooler chest.
- Outdoor clothes drying is not permitted. Please do not tie anything to our trees or electrical boxes. A laundry room is located inside the bath house building. Any

camper who ties a line to a tree or shrub will be held financially liable for any damage. Trees are expensive so please observe these rules.

- Pets are permitted on campsites but not in any of the cabins. Please check with the office as breed restrictions apply. Your pet (dogs and cats) must be leashed at all times when outside, must wear a current rabies ID tag, must not be left unattended (they cannot be outside your RV), and you must clean up after them immediately. We reserve the right (and you agree to pay) a \$25.00 clean up fee for each pile of pet waste we remove.
- Barking dogs disturb your fellow camper. We take barking complaints seriously and ask that you take appropriate steps to make sure that your dog does not disturb others. After receiving an initial complaint, we will visit your site and ask you to take appropriate measures to silence your pet. We will contact Animal Control if the pet has been left unattended. A second complaint will result in your being asked to either muzzle the dog or take it inside your camper. Any subsequent complaints will result in your being asked to remove the pet from the property. You agree to immediately comply with our requests.

Most importantly, management reserves the right to ask any camper found to be violating any of the above rules to leave the property immediately, and without refund or adjustment. Your signature on the registration slips or completed night slip acknowledges your understanding of our rules and shall serve as your voluntary consent to leave the property at once and without refund if so requested. We are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. [Revised 7/12]
